
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE
REGULATION OF LARGE ANIMALS


Section 1. Large Animals. Large animals shall be defined as those animals as provided in Scott County Code of Ordinances Section 9-2-1 with an animal unit measurement of 1.0 or greater to include slaughter steer or heifer, cow and calf pair, mature dairy cow, or horse.

Section 2. Limitation on Large Animals Within Township. Large animals as defined herein shall not be kept, boarded or permitted on any property within an RR-2 zoning district which has been previously subdivided into residential lots to RR-2 standards as a plat pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Ch. 505.

Section 3. Violation. Any person or property owner violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
